Walter E. Baethgen is Senior Research Scientist, Director of the Regional and Sectoral research program in the IRI, Columbia University. He acted as Director of the Agriculture and Food Security Center at Columbia University. He has been establishing research and education programs that aim to improve climate risk management in agriculture, water resources, and natural ecosystems. He acted as Distinguished Lead Scholar of the Fulbright Foundation's NEXUS Program for connecting science and policy. Before joining the IRI, Baethgen was a Senior Scientist in IFDC where he worked in Decision Support Systems. Baethgen acted as consultant for the United Nations (UNDP, UNIDO, FAO, IAEA), the World Bank, the IADB, and IICA. He also acted as a consultant to governments and the private sector of several countries throughout Latin America. He was an author in IPCC's Second, Third and Fourth Assessment Reports. He has served in scientific advisory committees of international organizations including CGIAR, IAI, IGBP and WMO. Baethgen obtained his PhD and MSc degrees in Crop and Soil Environmental Sciences from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, and his B.Sc. in Agricultural Engineering from the University of Uruguay. He has over 150 publications to his credit.
